The By-Laws, Policies & Procedures state:

4001.3 – Warrants of Appointment

A Warrant of Appointment is signed by the Chief Scout & can be used as an optional form of recognition to signify that an adult volunteer has been invested as a Scouter.

Warrants of Appointment are issued by Councils at their discretion.

Therefore, the criteria for a New Brunswick Scouter to receive a Warrant of Appointment is as follows:

- **must have completed the Scouts Canada screening process;**
- **must be currently registered as a member of Scouts Canada; &**
- **must have been invested as a Scouter.**
